Absolutely Not Permitted in the Area

- Alcohol and/or illegal substances of any kind
- Weapons such as, but not limited to, firearms, bows and arrows
- Fires anywhere outside the fire ring located at the pavilion/shelter
- Altering of landscape, digging and other man-made alterations
- Littering or trash disposal in any form
- Pets not accompanied by or under the control of their owners

Permitted with Prior Approval, Subject to Conditions

- Overnight camping for scouts or youth groups
- Fishing
- Mountain biking
- Private use of pavilion/shelter and activity area, by reservation

Hours & Availability

- Open daily, daylight to dark
- Closed during Ohio deer season

Reserve the Pavilion/Shelter

- Cost is \$25 per day for private use
- No charge for nonprofit organizations
- Call for availability
